

Membership Growth





Zimbabwe

Goal is to set up CiC Zimbabwe

Pastors in Zimbabwe hope CiC Zimbabwe will address the following needs:

- Young ministers: helping to overcome the obstacles and barriers that prevent young ministers from setting up independent churches and ministries.
- Accreditation: the provision of accreditation for those who are setting up ministries and chaplaincies, so that ministers can serve in hospitals, prisons, schools and other statutory/public settings.
- Accountability: for independent leaders
- Mutual encouragement: combatting the isolation and loneliness felt by many independent minister
- Recognition: shining a spotlight on the incredible work of churches and ministries serving those in poverty, with a view to strengthening relationships with the state.

Progress:

- We have been meeting with a group of 7-10 pastors on Zoom
- 5 have applied to join CiC as international members

hold a valid DBS certificate and


